### Connecting your XO laptop to the network

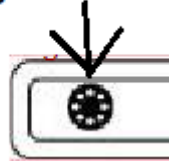
XO laptop can be connected to the network (WIFI) through the two interfaces (sugar labs and Gnome):


#### Sugar labs interface

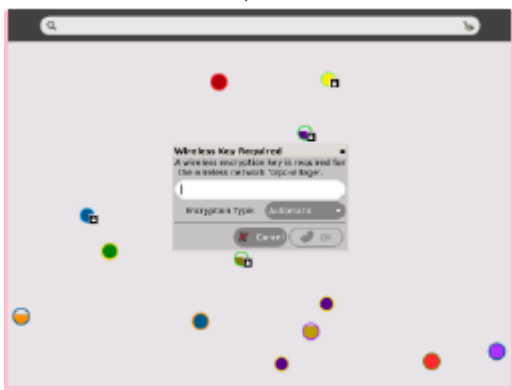


To get a wireless network connection, follow these Steps:

#### Neighborhood



1. Press  or the Neighborhood button at the top of the keyboard to go to the Neighborhood View.
2. Roll the pointer over one of the network access circles until you recognize the name of the wireless network. A circle with a lock icon requires a wireless key (a password.)
3. To connect, click a network access circle, and enter the wireless key if prompted.



#### Wireless key requested

once your XO is connected, you can use the Browse Activity to access the internet. To disconnect from the network, mover the pointer over the access point and click Disconnect.



### **Browse Activity**

When you are connected to the network, you can read web pages from the Internet. Browse the internet using a web browser

## Gnome Interface

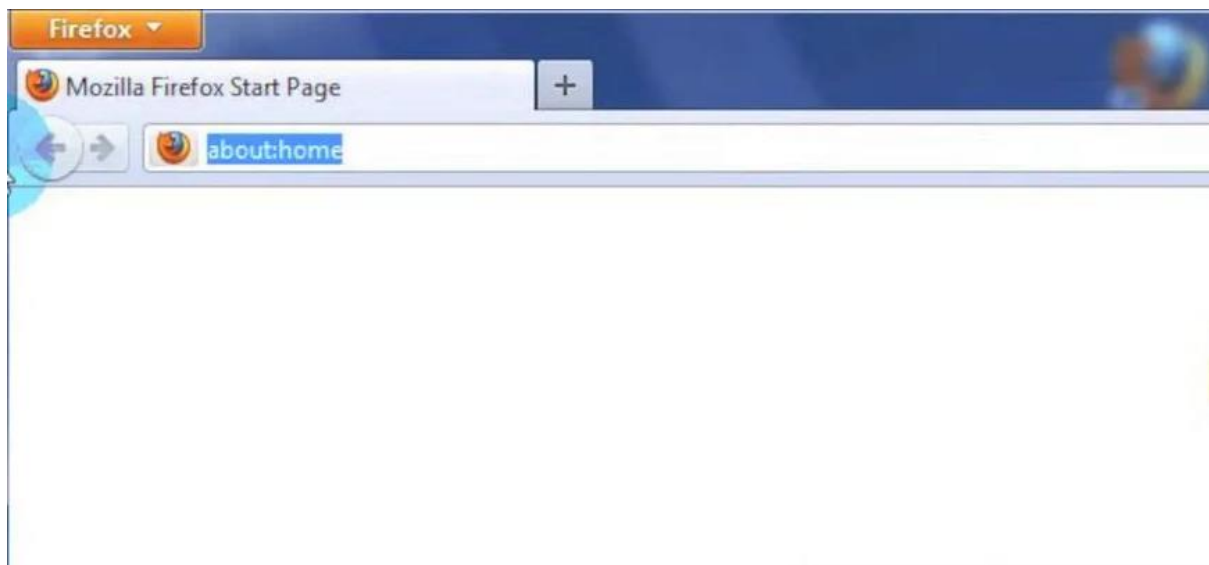
### 1. Connect to the access point

Click to two computers with x in red color, and then select the name of the WIFI you are using and put the password if required.



### 2. Open Browser

A. Firefox, click on it and open, write in the URL the web address you need to visit.



B. Epiphany browser

Click on Applications, >>> Internet then click on Epiphany.
